## DAY 1

### Welcome to Greece

Your Grecian holiday begins as you arrive in Athens and are transferred to your hotel to relax and freshen up after your journey. Later, join your fellow travel companions for a Welcome Reception to toast to our adventures ahead.

## DAY 2

### Discover Athens

Today we explore the "Cradle of Civilization" with a guided tour that includes the famous sites of both ancient and modern Athens. Visit the Acropolis, Parthenon, Royal Palace, Temple of Zeus and the Agora. Later we will take a relaxing trip to the southern most tip of the mainland to see the Temple of Poseidon at Cape Sounion. Marvel at the rugged coastline and temple perched above the sea. Stand high above the world's first-ever lighthouse that is steeped in classical Greek history. This evening we enjoy a true Greek fish/seafood dinner seaside at one of the most popular local tavernas.

## DAY 3

### Kalambaka

We depart Athens on our way to Thermopylae, a famous mountain pass where King Leonidas led his Spartan army and soldiers into battle against the Persians in 480 B.C. See the memorial dedicated to Leonidas before we continue on to Kalambaka for the night.

## DAY 4

### Meteora to Delphi

Perched high on top of gigantic rocks which seem to be suspended in mid-air, stand the Byzantine Monestaries, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit one of the monasteries before turning south through the foothills of Mount Parnassus. As we ascend the Sacred Way of Delphi, we pass the Parian marble Treasury of the Athenians and the Polygonal Wall with perfectly intact interlocking stones that have stood for thousands of years. Approach the Temple of Apollo where the Oracle of Delphi made her prophecies and predictions for 14 centuries.

## DAY 5

### Delphi to Olympia

As our adventures continue, we make our way to Olympia, the ancient site where the Olympic Games began in 776 B.C. as a dedication to Zeus. Tonight is a special evening as we join the Karambellas family for dinner at their olive farm and vineyard for an authentic experience featuring traditional dancing and Greek hospitality.

## DAY 6

### Mycenae to Athens

Arriving in Mycenae, a mighty kingdom in Ancient Greece, we will see the Beehive Tombs, Lion Gate and what remains of the Agamemnon's Royal Palace. Continue through to Epidaurus to visit the ancient theatre and view the Sanctuary of Asclepius, the God of Medicine whose snake-entwined staff is still the symbol of medicine today. Cross over the Corinth Canal as we return to Athens for the night.

## DAY 7

### Sail Across the Med to Santorini

Today we depart Athens for splendid Santorini, an island with a reputation for its picture-perfect panoramas, romantic sunsets and volcanic sand beaches and blue domed, whitewashed facades. This evening join your travel companions for a memorable Greek meal.

### Santorini Sunsets

Climb to the top to experience an active volcano or stay onboard and enjoy the incredible views. Afterwards, swim in the thermal waters of the hot springs. Back onboard, we will enjoy a casual light dinner accompanied with wine and music as we marvel at the sunset and village of Oia high above the cliffside.
